SPECIAL AGENT PETER W. TAUB

Special Agent (SSgt) Peter W. Taub graduated from Cheltenham High School, Wyncote, Pa., in 2004. He earned three Associate in Applied Science degrees through the Community College of the Air Force in Aircraft Armament Systems Technology, General Education, and Criminal Justice while receiving his Bachelor of Science degree in Cyber Security from the University of Maryland, University College, in 2015.

He enlisted in the Air Force in 2007, and following basic training and Aircraft Armament Systems technical training in 2008, he was assigned to Kadena Air Base, Japan, as an F-15 weapons load crew member where he was critical to the Pacific Command's armed response and deterrence to rising adversarial tensions in the Pacific theatre and region. SA Taub was reassigned to Ellsworth Air Force Base, S.D., in 2011 as a B-1B bomber weapons load crew member until 2013. He was recognized for leading his weapons load crew in their selection as the "Hot Shot" Load Crew of the Year for 2011.



SA Taub was selected into AFOSI in 2013, and upon graduation from the United States Air Force Special Investigations Academy at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center, Brunswick, Ga., he returned to Ellsworth Air Force Base as a Special Agent performing a wide range of investigative duties at AFOSI Detachment 816. He deployed to Expeditionary Detachment 2405, Bagram Air Base, Afghanistan, in support of Operation Freedom's Sentinel in October 2015.
