HOW TO SUBMIT A TIP

1. Log into www.p3tips.com/1111 or scan the QR code from your mobile device
2. Provide the **Who, What, When, Where and How do you know** of the information you are reporting
3. Use the **drop-down menus** to provide additional data related to your tip
4. Hit **Submit**

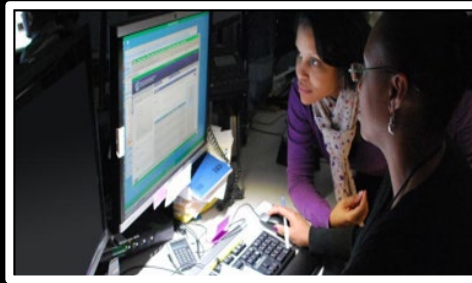

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What types of crimes should I report?

You should report counterintelligence concerns, force protection matters, or criminal activities including homicide, rape, sexual assault, child physical and sexual abuse, larceny of government and personal property, and aggravated assault. When in doubt – report it. Do not transmit suspected classified information.

How do I submit a tip to OSI?

Visit www.p3tips.com/1111 from a desktop or use the QR code to access the portal from your mobile device.

What happens when I submit a tip to the tip portal?

When you submit a tip, you will receive a unique tip number and will be able to correspond directly with OSI. You will be able to provide additional information and may attach photos and documents to support your tip. Check your tip submission to see if further information is needed to resolve the matter reported.

Can I provide contact information?

You have the option to submit personal contact information or to remain anonymous.

Can I still call or go directly to my local OSI Unit to report a tip?

Yes, contact information can be obtained from your local base directory.
